4.MISSION STATEMENT:

HHYWEF: mission is ' *To provide Quality and Sustainable Basic Educational Programmes(QSBTEP) from early grades to Tertiary so as to alleviate poverty among orphans, vulnerable children, children with Special Education Needs(SEN) youths, elders and the aged in Serenje and the Nation.*

5.OBJECTIVES

HHYWEF: *Is grounded on the following Goals;*

- e. To help the government in bridging the teacher learner ratio disparities in the rural based schools through (TEP).
- f. To relieve vulnerable guardians such as old grandparents from straggling for financial support to send their vulnerable youths to Tertiary Education.
- g. To mobilise resources for sustainability of support to orphans and vulnerable children through income generating activities, lobbying from donors and sponsors (individuals, Governmental/Non-Governmental & business organisations, the local and traditional leadership).
- h. To sensitise the community on importance of literacy education in poverty alleviation.
- i. To provide psychosocial support for *orphans, vulnerable children, youths, elders and the aged* including *children with Special Education Needs (SEN)* through counselling and the provision of social amenities platform such as sporting, cultural and other related activities,

6. STRATAGEMS AND ACTIVITIES:

- a. Educational sponsorship to facilitate primary and Tertiary attendance.
- b. Formation of Youths and Women Community Literacy Programmes (YWCLP)
- c. Mobilisation of children and youths in the community who might have either not started or fell out of school to go back to school
- d. Provision of psychosocial counselling to those children in need.
- e. Provision of health education and care so that children are kept safe and healthy.
- f. Provision of personal life skills training so that children learn responsibility to take care of themselves (e.g. washing to maintain

their own personal hygiene, caring for their clothing and shoes, avoiding unsafe situations, etc).

- g. Seeking (occasional) sponsorship for the medical support (and rehabilitation) of orphans with disabilities.
- h. Liaising and working with overseas sponsors to increase local sustainability for the project.
- i. Assisting graduating and reintegrated orphans in job seeking and sponsoring (where possible) appropriate training programs.
- j. Identification of extended families for the homeless orphans.
